15.Team Official Quota	Athlete & team official ratio is 1:1; Additional 1 Team Manager, 1 Coach per Team/Pair, 1 Medical Staff are allowed.					
16. Insurance	Participants are responsible for their own travel, health and personal accident insurance.
